VIEW-hub Data Update Process

1. Google News alerts to notify VIEW-hub team of any vaccine introductions mentioned in the press
 - Then verified with partners at WHO, Gavi, and internally
2. Work with IVAC internal and external partners to keep VIEW-hub updated on any new introductions
3. Targeted quarterly searches for new introductions using WHO and Gavi resources (i.e., WHO Immunization Repository, WHO Immunization Data portal)
4. Conduct full data audits every 6 months to ensure that all introductions have been included and any additional data is updated



VIEW-hub Data Collection

- Data presented on VIEW-hub are continually updated at intervals based upon the frequency of data release or data availability.
- Data cleaning, updating, and basic data management tasks are performed by members of the VIEW-hub team at IVAC.
- Immunization colleagues internally within IVAC as well as external groups (e.g., WHO, Gavi) are routinely consulted about new updates or for verification/confirmation of data.
- A data audit is conducted every 6 months. The last exhaustive review of data was conducted in October 2022.

Vaccine introductions (national or subnational)	Varies	Google news alerts
	Quarterly	WHO and Gavi resources (i.e., WHO Immunization Repository , WHO Immunization Data portal)
Vaccine updates (Gavi status, product switches, etc.)	Every 6 months*	Web, WHO, Gavi resources (i.e., WHO Immunization Repository , WHO Immunization Data portal)

*Data may be updated more frequently if VIEW-hub team is notified of any updates
